## Rehabilitation Foundation for Disabled Persons Inc., U.S.

Working through Ontario March of Dimes, the Rehabilitation Foundation for Disabled Persons Inc., U.S. (RFDP, U.S.) supports polio survivors and those experiencing post-polio syndrome, or the late effects of poliomyelitis by providing free educational packages to polio survivors, their caregivers and health care professionals as well as connecting survivors with local peer support groups for emotional and social interaction. Survivors also have access to a free online chat forum. These programs can be accessed from anywhere in the United States or abroad via the Internet, as well as through a toll-free info-line.

As of March 31, 2008 the corporation did not have any assets, liabilities or fund balances or incur any expenses for the year ended March 31, 2008. The corporation received \$5000 USD which the board decided to transfer to Ontario March of Dimes for services in Canada.


