Rehabilitation Foundation for Disabled Persons Inc., U.S. (RFDP US) received a gift of \$3000.00 (U.S.) from an American donor. The Board has been considering options as to how the funds that have been donated to RFDP US might best be used.

In March 2011, a group of parents in Detroit, Michigan invited March of Dimes to provide a series of Conductive Education classes. The classes were completed in April and were self funding. This is potentially an area requiring the oversight of the RFDP US Board.

In late 2010, President and C.E.O. Andria Spindel, and Director of Fund Development and Communications, Mary Lynne Stewart, travelled to California to meet with March of Dimes Canada spokesman, William Shatner, to oversee the production of several Public Service Announcements and other material.

While there, they met with a local community group, Canadians Abroad, to discuss the potential of having a local fundraiser in Los Angeles that would benefit March of Dimes Canada. Working with the Canada California Business Council and Canadians Abroad, March of Dimes Canada has been offered a unique opportunity to be the charity of choice for a golf tournament to be organized in southern California.

On May 17, 2011 a special event was held at the Riverside County Economic Development office celebrating Canada Day. The Chair of RFDP US, Ed Cieszkowski, attended on behalf of March of Dimes Canada. The Canada California Business Council announced that a golf tournament for March of Dimes Canada would be held on January 21, 2012 at the Desert Dunes Golf Club in Palm Desert.

This will be the first major event to be held in the U.S. that will benefit March of Dimes Canada.
