



# Getting Quotations for Home Modifications, Adaptations and Devices



## To locate potential vendors and contractors:

- Check local newspapers & magazines -
- Search Online to find vendors and contractors in your area and check reviews -
- Ask your Occupational Therapist -
- Ask family members, friends, and neighbors for referrals -

## Quotations Must Include:

- All equipment and labour charges (Itemized costs with price totals and taxes listed)
- A detailed description of the work to be completed

## For Construction Projects:

All quotes for construction work must include WSIB certificates from those completing the work.

- Pre-Photos, Drawings and Measurements are required for Construction Projects

## Other Things to Consider:

- Consider reviews, warranties and timelines. For construction projects, consider the proposed plan and if any work needs to be sub-contracted out.
- Ensure you understand what permits may be required and who will be obtaining them. Discuss what areas of your home will be impacted while the work is underway so you know if you will need to make alternate arrangements.
- The Program funds basic and essential solutions to physical barriers that impede mobility. You must negotiate any cosmetic or therapeutic upgrades with your contractor(s), at your own expense.
